

Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. When does the virtual ECTC open?**
 - a. The conference is scheduled to open at 9:00AM Eastern Time on June 3rd, 2020.
- 2. When does the virtual conference end?**
 - a. The conference is scheduled to close at 5:00PM Eastern Time on June 30th, 2020.
- 3. Will there be any live sessions or presentations?**
 - a. No. The entire conference will be presented as on-demand pre-recorded video presentations.
- 4. Will all the presentations of the conference be accessible simultaneously or will they be released for viewing at any specific schedule?**
 - a. The presentations of the conference will be accessible simultaneously and remain available for viewing during the time the conference is open.
- 5. Will the pre-recorded videos be available to download?**
 - a. No. Attendees must login to the virtual conference and watch the presentations as streaming video content.
- 6. Will the video presentations be available after the conference ends?**
 - a. No. The videos will be destroyed after the conference ends on June 30, 2020.
- 7. What is the cost to attend the conference?**
 - a. It is free to attend the conference.
- 8. How do I register for the ECTC 2020 Virtual Conference?**
 - a. Please register, for free, through the ECTC website (www.ectc.net)
- 9. Will the virtual ECTC have a published conference proceeding?**
 - a. Yes, the virtual ECTC will include a published proceeding of the conference.
- 10. Will there be a cost associated with the proceedings?**
 - a. An electronic copy of the proceedings is \$100.
- 11. How and when will the proceeding be delivered?**
 - a. Instructions for downloading the proceedings will be sent on June 3, 2020, once the conference begins. If you purchase the proceedings from June 3 – June 30 you will receive instructions after purchase.
- 12. Will I be able to purchase the proceedings through ECTC after the conference closes on June 30, 2020?**
 - a. No
- 13. Will papers presented at the virtual conference be included in the IEEE Xplore digital library?**
 - a. Yes, they should be available sometime in July, 2020.
- 14. Will there be any Professional Development Courses offered through the virtual conference?**
 - a. No
- 15. How do I interact with an author if I have questions on the contents of the paper?**
 - a. The virtual platform allows for questions to be posted privately on the pages the pre-recorded presentation videos are played by the attendees. The author will have the opportunity to engage with the asker directly via email.

 - a. Yes.
